Object for the following reasons: Not a comprehensive development of the whole site (ie it would prevent redevelopment of the gardens of the other

houses fronting onto Furlong Road). Design of building is very poor and lacks character. Building is way too large for the size of the plot (plot density in appropriate in this area), and is unneighbourly and overlooks Eghams Court and the backs of the properties fronting Furlong Road, causing a loss of privacy. Also concerned about loss of quality of amenity caused by vicinity of parking areas with gardens. Concern about increase in number of traffic movements exacerbating an existing problem area. Layout of parking would provide a dead and lifeless frontage, and should be broken up with planting and there is a lack of a landscaping plan which would provide a secure hawthorne hedge with existing back gardens.

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
